Mayor David Sims called the special council meeting of February 9, 2018 to order at 4:40 p.m. Present for the meeting were Mayor Sims, Council President Rick Alonzo, Council Members Ron Smith, Valerie Thompson, and Adam Arthur, Clerk Kris Larson, Engineer/Administrator Mike Klaus, and Attorney Andrakay Pluid.

The purpose of the special council meeting was to consider hire of a clerk/treasurer.

At 4:40 p.m. Rick Alonzo moved to go into executive session per Idaho Code 74-206, Subsection 1 (a) to consider hiring a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent, wherein the respective qualities of individuals are to be evaluated in order to fill a particular vacancy or need. This paragraph does not apply to filling a vacancy in an elective office or deliberations about staffing needs in general. Ron Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed – Ron Smith "yes", Rick Alonzo "yes", Valerie Thompson "yes", Adam Arthur "yes". Executive session ended at 4:59 p.m. No action was taken.

Mayor Sims said he would like to appoint Andres Tolosa. Rick Alonzo moved to hire Andres Tolosa for the Clerk/Treasurer position to be appointed on March 6, 2018 at a starting salary of \$52,000 per year pending background check and drug screen. Attorney Andrakay Pluid said this is not a safety sensitive position, and she does not think we can drug test him. She explained safety sensitive positions to the group. Ron Smith thinks there is a difference between preemployment and safety sensitive drug testing. Valerie Thompson seconded the motion. The motion passed – Ron Smith "yes", Rick Alonzo "yes", Valerie Thompson "yes", Adam Arthur "yes".
